### **Anachronauts to Play at the Trolley Stop**

Anachronauts, the band not of hard rock but of hard science, will play from 9:30-11:30 Friday, February 24th at the Trolley Stop. The Trolley Stop is located at 530 E. 5th Street in downtown Dayton and has recently begun to specialize in coffee. Admission will be free.

Anachronauts is an acoustic trio which plays original music that has been described as "sci-fi folk" due to its homemade feel and lyrical themes which include plastic, perpetual motion, and apocalypse. Their music is characterized by two-part harmony and male-female vocal interplay.

Anachronauts was formed in New Orleans in 1990 and relocated to Dayton in August of last year. While in Louisiana they played in variety of venues from bookstores and art galleries to coffeehouses and clubs, including the Neutral Ground Coffeehouse, Native Naive Art Gallery, and Muddy Waters' music club. Since the move, Steve Forte, who is also front man for Dayton's Beeer Pagans, has joined Anachronauts and plays acoustic guitar, mandolin, and slide guitar for the group.

All three of the members of Anachronauts work for Wright State University Libraries. Scott and Stacey Burright are professional librarians working in Wright State's Dunbar and Fordham Libraries, respectively, and Steve Forte is a library assistant in Wright State's Dunbar Library.
